

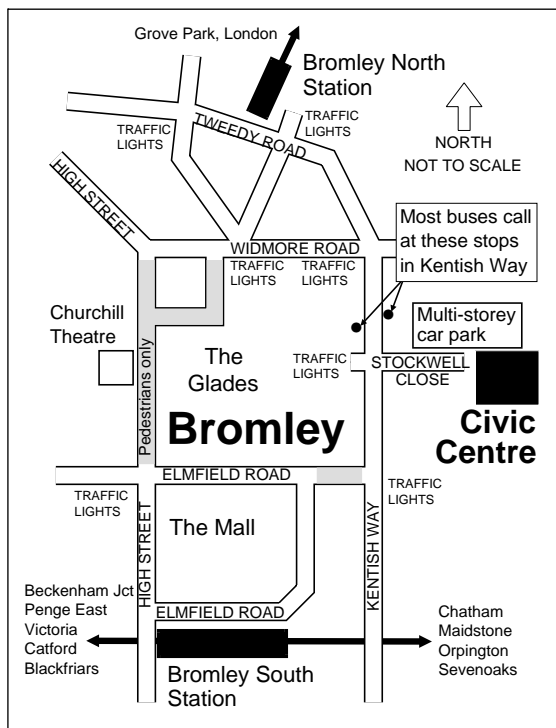
Evening Meetings in Bromley

Meetings are held in the Great Hall of Bromley Civic Centre, Stockwell Close, Kentish Way, Bromley, BR1 3UH at 8pm usually on the second Wednesday of each month. Doors open at 7pm. Most meetings consist of an illustrated lecture lasting about an hour on a topic connected with the National Trust and its fields of interest.

Parking is available in the adjacent multi-storey car park. Many buses stop nearby in Kentish Way and the Great Hall is about ten minutes walk from Bromley South and Bromley North stations. The Great Hall of Bromley Civic Centre has disabled access and facilities.

Admission is £2.50 for members of the Centre and £3.00 for visitors.



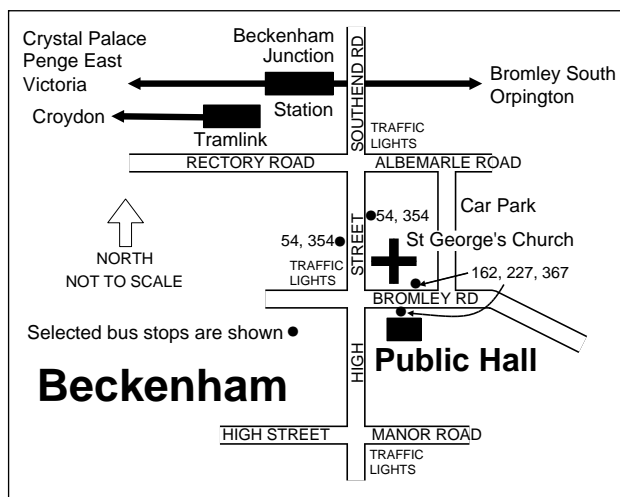
Afternoon Meetings in Beckenham

Meetings are held in the Public Hall, 4 Bromley Road, Beckenham, BR3 5JE at 2.30pm usually on the third Thursday of each month from September to May inclusive, except December when it is on the first Thursday. Doors open at 2pm. Most meetings consist of an illustrated lecture lasting about an hour on a topic connected with the National Trust and its fields of interest.

Beckenham Public Hall is in Bromley Road, opposite St George's Church. Parking is available nearby. Buses stop close to the Public Hall and it is about five minutes walk from Beckenham Junction station and Tramlink stop. The Public Hall has disabled access and facilities.

Admission is £2.50 for members of the Centre and £3.00 for visitors.



Visits

The Centre organises visits to places of interest, including National Trust properties, throughout the year. Many visits take place by coach from Beckenham and Bromley. Members may take a picnic lunch or eat in a pub or café if they prefer.

Tickets are sold at meetings shortly before the visit, the costs varying according to the attraction and the distance covered. The visits are arranged for members of the Centre but friends of members are welcome to purchase unsold tickets.
