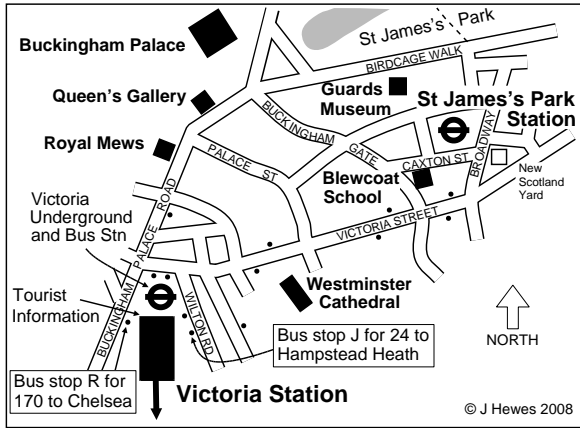

Open: M-F 1000-1730 (1900 Thur Apr-Dec).

Train to Victoria (zone 1) then 10 minutes walk.

Underground to St James's Park (zone 1).

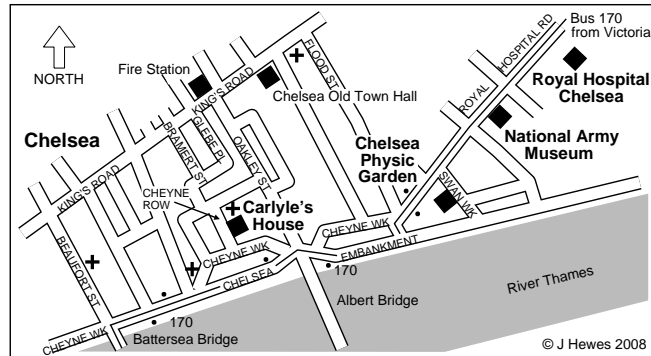
Buses 11, 24, 148, 211 and 507 stop in Victoria St.

Open: mid Mar-Oct, WThF 1400-1700, SSuBH 1100-1700. Tel. 020 7352 7087.

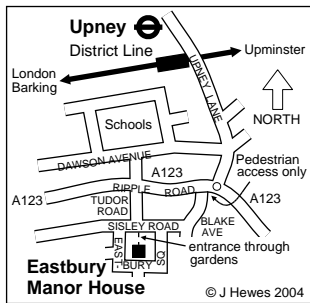
Train or Underground to Victoria (zone 1), then ... Bus 170 from Victoria stop R (map above) to the Albert Bridge, then about 3 minutes walk.



### Eastbury Manor House

Open: MT (also 1st & 2nd Sat in month) 1000-1600, closed BH. Tel. 020 8724 1002.

Underground District Line to Upney (zone 4), then 10 minutes walk.



### Fenton House

Open: mid Mar-Oct, WThF 1400-1700, SSu & BH 1100-1700. Mar, SSu 1400-1700. Tel. 020 7435 3471.

### 2 Willow Road

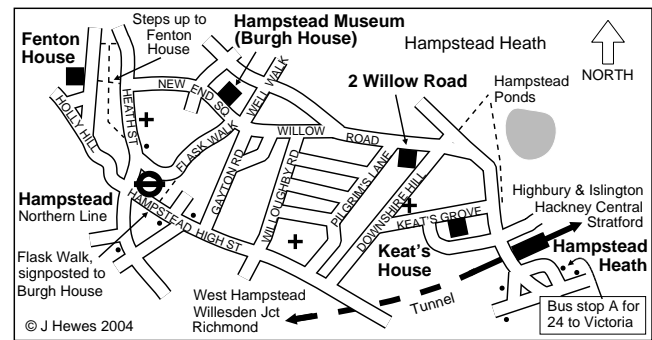
Open: Apr-Oct, ThF 1200-1700, Sat 1100-1700; also Mar & Nov, Sat 1100-1700. Tel. 020 7435 6166.

London Overground to Hampstead Heath (zone 2) (Richmond - Highbury & Islington - Stratford) every 15 minutes (30 minutes Sun). Then 10 minutes walk to 2 Willow Road, or 25 minutes uphill to Fenton House.

Underground Northern Line to Hampstead (zone 2/3) on the Edgware branch (if no Edgware train is shown, change at Camden Town). Fenton House is about 10 minutes walk uphill, 2 Willow Road is 15 minutes walk.

Bus 24 from Victoria (stop J) and near Charing Cross (stop C in Trafalgar Square) to Hampstead Heath station (the end of the route), then 10 minutes walk to 2 Willow Road, or 25 minutes uphill to Fenton House.

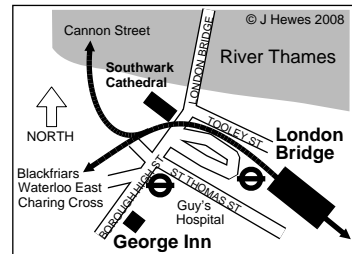
To visit both properties it is probably easiest to start at Fenton House then walk downhill to 2 Willow Road.



### George Inn

Open: Licensing hours. Tel. 020 7407 2056.

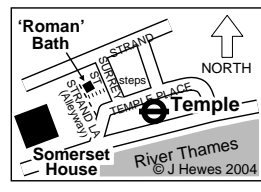
Train or Underground to London Bridge (zone 1), then 5 minutes walk, or only 2 minutes from the Underground's Borough High St exit.



### 'Roman' Bath

Open: by appointment tel. 020 8232 5050, but it can be seen at all times through a window.

Underground to Temple (zone 1), then 3 minutes walk.



### Ham House and Garden

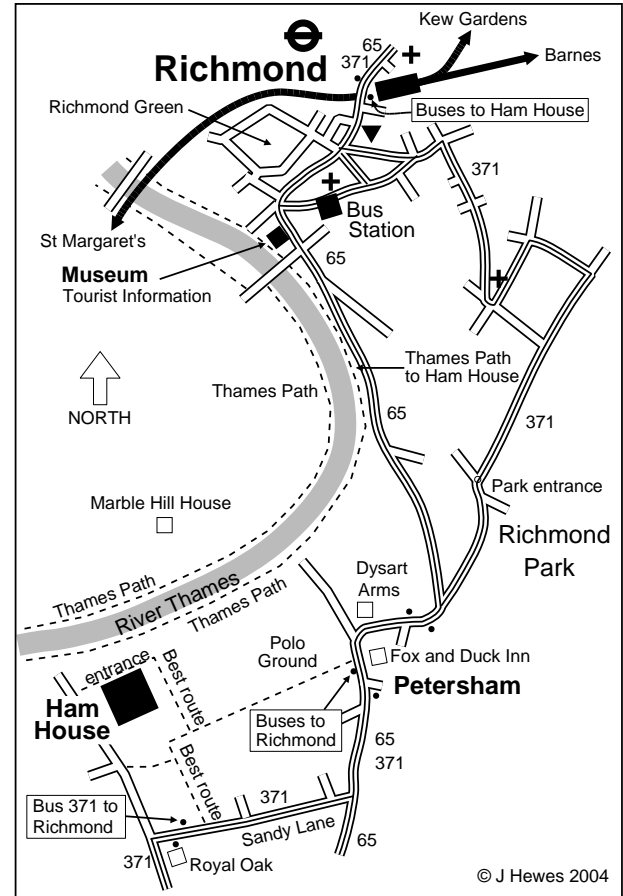
Open: mid Mar-Oct, MTWSSu 1200-1600. Garden all year MTWSSu 1100-1800. Tel. 020 8940 1950.

Train from Waterloo or Underground District Line to Richmond (zone 4) then bus 65 or 371 (shorter walk).

Bus 65 from Richmond station to Petersham (8 minutes journey) and about 20 minutes walk (3/4 mile).

Bus 371 from Richmond station to the Royal Oak (15 minutes journey) and about 15 minutes walk (1/2 mile).

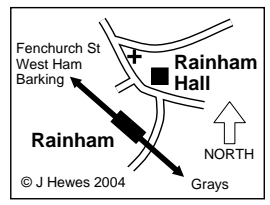
You may prefer to walk 1 3/4 miles from the station to Ham House via the Thames Path, allow 45 minutes.



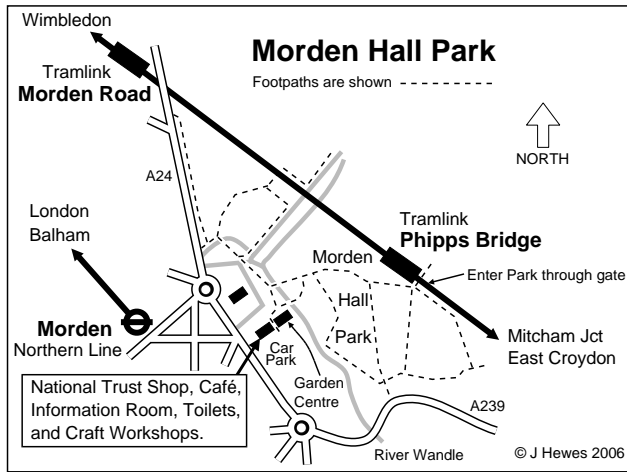
### Rainham Hall

Open: Apr-Oct, Sat 1400-1700. Tel. 020 7799 4552.

Train every 30 minutes from Fenchurch Street, Barking or West Ham to Rainham (zone 6), then 5 minutes walk.

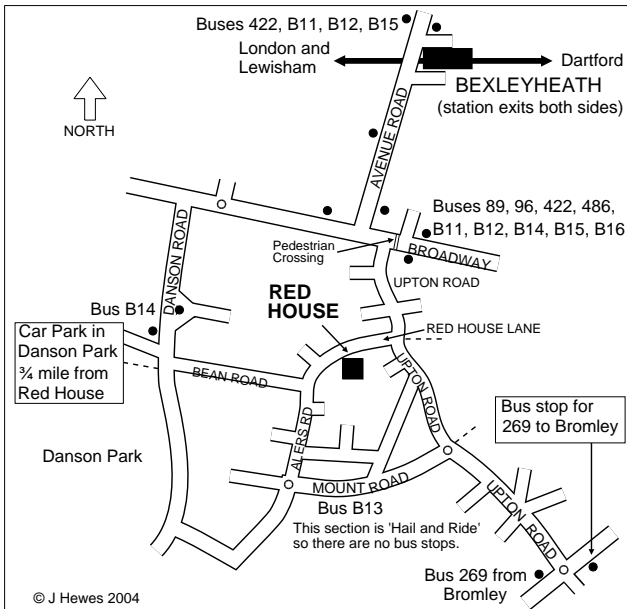


**Morden Hall Park** Tel. 020 8545 6850.  
 Open: Daily 0800-1800, café & shop open 1000-1700.  
**Tramlink** (Wimbledon line) to Phipps Bridge (zone 4).  
**Underground** Northern Line to **Morden**, 5 min. walk.

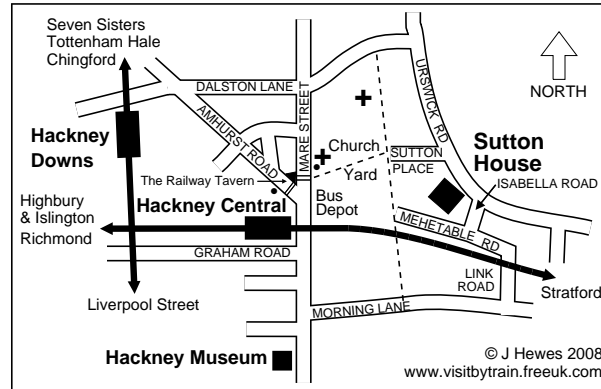


**Red House**

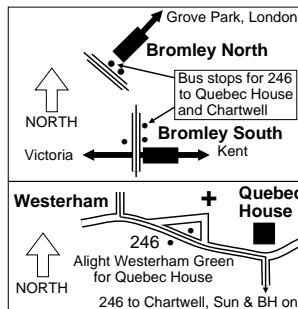
Open: Mar-Dec WThFSSu & BH 1100-1645. Admission by pre-booked guided tour only, tel. 020 8304 9878.  
**Train** from Charing Cross, Waterloo East, London Bridge or Lewisham (also Victoria M-S only) to **Bexleyheath** (zone 5) then 20 minutes walk (¾ mile).  
**Bus 269** from Bromley North to Bexleyheath, Upton Road, then 20 minutes walk (¾ mile).



**Sutton House** Tel. 020 8986 2264.  
 Open: Feb-Dec, ThFSSu & BH 1230-1630.  
**London Overground** to **Hackney Central** (zone 2) (Richmond - Highbury & Islington - Stratford) every 15 minutes (30 minutes Sun), then 10 minutes walk.  
**Underground** Victoria Line to **Highbury & Islington**, or Jubilee Line to **Stratford**, then London Overground to Hackney Central, 10 minutes walk.  
**Buses** to Hackney Central (10 minutes walk) include the **38** from Victoria (about 60 minutes journey) and the **48** from London Bridge (about 35 minutes journey).



**Chartwell - bus operates on Sun & BH only**  
 Open: mid Mar-Oct Su & BH (and WThFS) 1100-1700.  
**Quebec House**  
 Open: mid Mar-Oct, WThFSSu & BH 1300-1700.  
 Tel. 01732 868381 (for Chartwell and Quebec House).  
**Train** to Bromley North or Bromley South for bus 246.  
**Bus 246** from Bromley and Hayes to Westerham (for Quebec House) and Chartwell (Sun & BH only).  
**Wed-Sat Bus 246:** ½-hourly to Quebec House only.  
**Sun & BH Bus 246:** hourly at 25 (Bromley North) and 29/32 (Bromley South) minutes past each hour. The journey to Chartwell is about 45 minutes. The last return bus from Chartwell is at 1717. *These times were correct when published but may change.*  
**Travelcards** are valid to **Chartwell and Westerham on bus 246 although both places are outside London.**

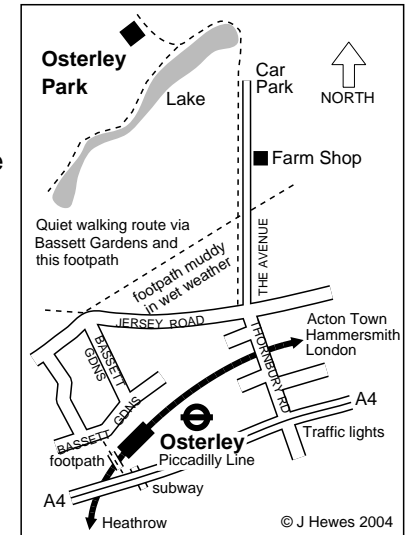

**Osterley Park**

Open: mid Mar-Oct WThFSSu 1300-1630. Park open daily all year 0800-1800. Tel. 020 8232 5050.  
**Underground** Piccadilly Line to **Osterley** (zone 4) on the Heathrow branch. Then about 20 minutes walk via the footpath shown.

**Train to Victoria** then Underground District Line Westbound to **Hammersmith** (take an Ealing Broadway or Richmond train). At Hammersmith cross the platform for the Piccadilly Line to **Osterley** (zone 4). On the return journey all District Line trains Eastbound from Hammersmith operate to Victoria.
